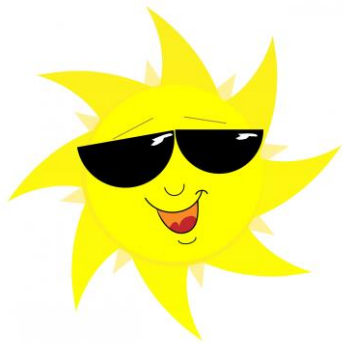

Wow, it's June! It is always an exciting, yet bittersweet, month for us. There is so much to look forward to, and so much to celebrate. We are very proud of the children and how they have worked hard, learned lots, and grown much! We look forward to celebrating them on Friday, June 23rd. Please note that we have decided to start the celebration at 11:00 a.m. so that we have more time for the special things we have planned.

Themes for this month are oceans and beaches, ecosystems, camping, and graduation. In math we will work on understanding and counting teen numbers. Then we will move on to count to 100 by ones and tens. Letters X, Y, and Z will guide us through "Letter Learning" (phonics), and we will review all of the short vowel sounds well. We will continue thinking about, and understanding, the books we read together by identifying the beginning, middle and end of a story; thinking about the characters, their traits and their feelings; as well as, the setting. In science we continue to question, hypothesize, experiment, and observe a variety of phenomenon. Creativity is also abundant in the Orange Room, as the children lead their own projects and dive into those we present while often expanding on them with their own ideas.

The children have worked hard to become a kind, caring, helpful community of learners. They are working on making great choices as a group to earn a pajama and movie day. As soon as the jar is full, we will celebrate on the following Friday.
