We have brainstormed some ideas to celebrate, which includes what we will do, eat, and wear. February brings the following topics to embed into our academic curricula – Groundhog's Day (seasons, weather, shadows), Artists (color theory, art media), Black History Month (leadership, innovation), Valentine's Day, Presidents' Day (leadership, coins, monuments, goals), and Dental Health. One of our Orange Room families is excited to plan a visit and teach us about presidents this month. We always welcome and enjoy our families coming in to teach us something that they value and want to share with others. In math, we will continue with flat (2-D) and solid (3-D) shapes. After we master describing these shapes, we will explore building various objects and pictures with them. Showing and writing teen numbers is next.
