Though January seemed to pass by quickly, the children learned a lot about acceptance, appreciation, and tolerance of diversity, and their friendships, as well as spirit of community within the classroom, grew even stronger. In fact, their teamwork earned them a special In-School Snow and Pajama Day. They enjoyed a cozy day in their jammies with lovies, hot chocolate, a Snowy Day movie, snowball fight, and special snack. All had snow much fun!

In February learning themes and topics will be: Groundhog Day, Chinese New Year, Inventors, Black History, Dental Health, 100<sup>th</sup> Day of School, Valentine's Day, Presidents, and Friendships. A lot will be packed into a short month with a break the week of 2/21. School will be closed on 2/21; however, wrap-around care is available for the rest of the week. Please let us know if your child will attend some or all of the days so that we can plan accordingly.

The children have made nice gains in number sense involving 0-10 and are ready to identify and order numbers 11-20. After a review, subtraction within 0-10 will be introduced. We will also work with 2D shapes this month. Graphing and comparing amounts continues to be part of our everyday activities.

Comprehension of texts read in a small group and read aloud to the large group will continue to be part of our daily learning. Understanding of vocabulary is central to writing and drawing activities. We will continue to work with syllables within words, as well as, phonics with consonants and vowels in groups. All are demonstrating proficiency with tracking print and 1:1 correspondence.

Be on the lookout for the class list in your child's mail folder, as well as a Sign-up Genius email regarding Valentine's Day. We will also celebrate our 100<sup>th</sup> Day of School this month. In addition, Joey (Joanne) and Mr. Jason will be celebrating their birthdays this month – Happy Birthday, Joey; Happy Birthday, Mr. Jason!!
