Overarching themes for this month are:
New Year goals; Martin Luther King, Jr.,
justice and fairness; frozen water – ice and
snow; arctic animals, continents and BioDomes; and, Lego Engineering. Within
those themes, the following skills will be
introduced and practiced: addition and
subtraction within ten; teen numbers;
patterns; "stretching out" words using
beginning, middle (medial), and ending
sounds; digraphs (sh, ch, th, wh), and
basic sentence structure, including
punctuation. Simultaneously, writing
instruction and practice will begin. Much
more will be added as the children grow.

Leveled reading groups will continue and build upon skills previously learned. We will also continue to learn about rhyming and phonics (letter sounds). Sound spelling will help practice and extend the concept of phonics.

This month we will also change our daily schedule a bit to accommodate hungry morning-bellies. Historically we have combined morning greeting, morning message, calendar, weather, and number of the day activities. This year we will try having snack in between morning message and calendar/weather activities to access optimal attention and participation. This change will help everyone to practice flexibility, which we have learned and practiced a lot so far this year.
