Orange Room News

The Orange Room is excited to welcome March with the anticipation of longer days, Leprechaun visits, and the beginning of spring? We even already brainstormed ways to lure and trap a mischievous Leprechaun!

Overarching themes in March will include an author study on Jan Brett, fiction and non-fiction stories we love, St. Patrick's Day, weather, and Women's History. We have each created our own character, so now we will each create a setting for those characters so that we may write and illustrate our own story.

In our reading teams we will continue to work on letters and their sounds, initial letters of words, rhyming, word families, using syllabication and stretching out words to decode unfamiliar words, and adding more "Popcorn Words" to our list. In terms of comprehension, we will also continue to listen for important information, sequence/retell stories, identify problems and solutions, and make predictions. We have also been learning to read and spell our last names.

In math, we will finish our geometry unit by learning to build shapes and make pictures with them as well. Then, we will work on understanding addition and subtraction within 5, before moving on to addition and subtraction within 10. The difference from "making" given amounts using two groups, is that we will now use the symbols +, -, & =.

Our unit on weather will inspire us to do some cloud watching, experimenting with wind, and give us opportunities to look for signs of spring. Making and recording our observations will be the special focus of this unit. We will, undoubtedly, have inquisitive friends who ask about natural disasters and severe weather, so the questions will guide us through those topics as well.

Picture Day is on March 27th or 28th; look out for more details. Also, Ms. Katina has arranged for a K-9 Unit to visit our school on March 30th. This will be an exciting visiting field trip!

We will, however, celebrate St. Patrick's Day, spring, and leaders in Women's History!
