The Orange Room is excited to welcome March with the anticipation of longer days, Leprechaun visits, and the beginning of spring (hopefully)!

Overarching themes in March will include exploring fairy tales, St. Patrick's Day, Me on the Map, weather, and spring animals. We hope to have a friend of Ms. Chris' visit to teach us even more about animals and their habitats.

In our Learning Without Tears curriculum, we will read the letter books Kk, Jj, Ww, and Ee, and talk about each letter as a beginning sound. With these books we can explore understanding characters and their feelings, identifying main characters and settings, as well as being kind and helpful. New popcorn words this month will be: to, will, get, what, when, who, where, there, he, she.

We continuously work on letters and their sounds, initial letters of words, rhyming, using syllabication, and tuning into beginning middle and ending sounds in words. In terms of comprehension, we will also continue to listen for important information, sequence/retell stories, identify problems and solutions, and make predictions. We will introduce learning to read and spell our last names as well this month.

For math we will move on to explore shapes by describing and naming flat vs. solid shapes; shape and position; and comparing shapes based on attributes such as number of sides, curves, and vertices. Our geometry unit will also include learning to build shapes and make pictures with them as well.

Our units on maps and weather will inspire us to do some cloud watching, experimenting with wind, and give us opportunities to walk the neighborhood near school to look for signs of spring.
