Happy fall! After spending September getting to know each other and the rules and expectations of the classroom, we will begin to incorporate more content area instruction into our weekly curriculum, as well as expand on our English Language Arts (ELA) and Math curricula.

Subjects in content area instruction will include: Apples, Family, Fire Prevention, Diurnal (Daytime) and Nocturnal (Nighttime) Animals, and of course, Halloween. We will explore many fiction and nonfiction stories, as well as Scholastic Let's Find Out and Science Spin issues on these subjects. Learning Without Tears is our whole literacy approach curriculum. The letters Aa, Nn, Ss, Rr will be reviewed in October, and will include "Letter Learning" and "Meaning Making" activities to explore letter identification; phonics; story sequencing; and, understanding story events, feelings of characters, and story sequencing (beginning, middle, and end). The children love learning with Mat Man.

Topics in our iReady Math curriculum and supporting materials will cover the following: Making 3, 4, and 5 (precursor to addition), counting and writing to 10, understanding 1 more within quantities 0-10, and comparing quantities within 0-10. We also incorporate many mathematical skills practice into our Morning Meeting with patterning, counting by 1s and 10s to 100, counting calendar dates and recording weather data for comparisons and predictions.

The children have really enjoyed our specials so far. They include Amazing Athletes, gym, Social Skills Club, music class, art, and science. If families have any special talents or interests/hobbies to share with us, please let us know. We would love to invite special guests into our classroom to extend and support learning.
