Welcome to the Orange Room Aaron, Abigail, Adriano, Alessio, Brennan, Callen, Daniel, Elena, Emily, Emmett, Lexi, Michael, Niko, and Zen! We are excited to get to know you and your families. We have so many wonderful things planned to stimulate academic, physical, emotional and social development.

We will start off the year by taking some time to get to know each other and learn our kindergarten classroom routines, responsibilities and expectations. Classroom jobs will be an integral part of our day as we learn responsibility and pride in being part of a classroom community of learners and helpers. We will also use this time to build confidence and independence, as well as celebrate each of our unique qualities, as we participate in many "All About Me and My Family" activities.

Throughout the month of September we will introduce our math curricula and dive right into working with single digit numerals. We will also introduce our literacy program (Leveled Literacy Intervention by Fountas and Pinnell) and supportive activities to begin exploring letters, sounds and high frequency words ("Popcorn Words"). Finally, we will begin to explore autumn themed curriculum, including apples and the change in weather. The children will frequently participate in reading/listening, math, writing, social studies, puzzles/games, art, dramatic play, literacy and science and discovery. Our specials each week will include: Amazing Athletes, Gym, Social Skills, Fine Motor Skills/Art, and Music Class. Art, science, and social studies will be integrated into Structured Play, Learning Stations, and Fine Motor activities.

Please remember that the Orange Room school/academic day begins at 9am and we like to get busy right away so we can make the most of our time together!
